NTHL Vaccine Mandate

All NTHL participants (players, coaches, referees, technical directors, and athletic trainers) must have full COVID-19 vaccination (receive at least two doses of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine or single dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine) prior to their participation in NTHL events.

A copy of your COVID-19 vaccination document (provided at the time the vaccine is received) must receive submission to the NTHL as verification as described

below.

To meet the vaccination requirement, all participants are required to confirm their vaccination status via the [NTHL Health Portal](#). Individuals must have their vaccination document available on the device from which they are uploading the information.

- Complete sections 1-8 of the form
- Select “Vaccine Card/QR Code” from the Main Menu.
- Upload an image of your vaccination document (files accepted include: PNG, PDF, or JPEG).
- Sign and complete the form

In addition, league facilities may have their own requirements in order to gain access. In these cases, each participant must follow the procedures of that facility in order to participate.

Vaccine Exemption

The NTHL will review requests for medical and religious exemptions to the vaccination mandate, as provided for under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Exemption requests can take up to 10 business days to review once received.

MEDICAL EXEMPTION

You may request a vaccine exemption if you have a condition the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) considers a contraindication for the COVID-19 vaccination. Contraindications include a severe allergic reaction after a previous dose or to a component of the COVID-19 vaccine or an immediate allergic reaction of any severity to a previous dose or a known (diagnosed) allergy to any component of the vaccine. If seeking a medical exemption, you must consult with your physician and complete the [Medical Exemption Form](#).

- Upload an image of your vaccination document (files accepted include: PNG, PDF, or JPEG).
- Sign and complete the form

RELIGIOUS EXEMPTION

You may request a vaccine exemption if sincerely held religious beliefs or practices conflict with the COVID-19 vaccination requirement. If seeking a religious exemption, you must complete the [Religious Exemption Form](#).

- Complete sections 1-8 of the form
- Select “Vaccine Card/QR Code” from the Main Menu.
- Upload an image of your vaccination document (files accepted include: PNG, PDF, or JPEG).
- Sign and complete the form
